



2. The DWS prize which began in 2005 successfully ran this year with the prize money of £100 again sponsored by Taylor & Francis.
3. The postgraduate Travel Prize was awarded to Mariela Reyes, Kings College, London. This prize was awarded in late August 2006 and is not included in the above final accounts as the cheque was not deposited at the time of these accounts. Note that this award was raised to £700 from £500 for this financial year.
4. A cheque for £25.80 (cheque number 000383) was still not cashed at the time of these accounts. This was a committee expenses cheque dated 17 February 2006. This amount is thus not included in the above accounts.
5. The postgraduate Conference Award of £220 was awarded to Melanie Lombard, Sheffield University.
6. DARG was awarded one RGS-IBG grant during this period of £441.
7. The Overseas Conference Awards were given to Dr Hasbullah, and Dr Kenesh Djusipov for the 2006 RGS-IBG conference in London. They were each paid £500 with bank charges for the money transfer charged to DARG in addition to this sum. Dr Djusipov's total payment appears as £530 as Lloyds TSB incorrectly initially charged Dr Djusipov for the transaction and then later paid him an additional £30.00 at my request. DARG was in effect not charged any bank charges for his transaction making his payment 'equivalent' to Dr Hasbullah's.
